Curriculum: All UNIV 1840 instructors are required to structure their courses around the office-established learning objectives as approved by the University Senate. Specific learning outcomes and additional assignments are tailored by the instructor to meet the transition needs of the specific learning community's academic focus as well as the students in the class section and their community partner's needs.

Training: All instructors must complete at least five hours of training prior to teaching, including a new instructor orientation. In this academic year professional development provided included a full-day annual curricular conference, more than thirty hour-long seminars, and recorded webinars. Teaching and learning resources provided included a comprehensive instructor manual and a fully developed customizable course HuskyCT site.

Oversight: Each UNIV 1840 course must be fully vetted and approved by the First Year Programs and Learning Communities Faculty Courses and Curriculum Oversight Board. And each instructor must apply and be approved to teach by the First Year Programs and Learning Communities Faculty Courses and Curriculum Oversight Board. Syllabi are collected annually. And SET evaluations are reviewed so that any instructor with an average score of three or below can be provided with personalized remediation and support. All learning communities' courses are additionally under the oversight of a faculty director with expertise in the field of inquiry.
